



Volunteer Program at Marineland

Marineland volunteers play a vital role in meeting the education and conservation goals that define who Marineland Dolphin Adventure is and why we do what we do.

Some volunteer roles include:

Public Education – Greeting guests, directing those scheduled for a dolphin interactive experience to their program and interpreting the programs for other guests visiting the facility

Maintenance – Making daily rounds and fixing needed items to ensure the upkeep of Marineland facilities.

Life Support Operations - Assisting staff with maintaining the pipes and wires that support the exhibits.

What are the pre-requisites needed to apply to volunteer at Marineland Dolphin Adventure?

- 18 years or older
- U.S. citizen, or hold a current work visa, student visa or green card
- Good communication and interpersonal skills
- Ability to pass a background check and volunteer at least once a week
- Willingness to be outside and enthusiastic during their entire shift, regardless of the weather.

What are the benefits of volunteering at Marineland Dolphin Adventure?

- Unlimited Volunteer admission to Marineland Dolphin Adventure and Georgia Aquarium for each year as an active Volunteer
- Discounts on daily admission tickets for friends and family
- Ability to earn free daily admission tickets for a friend or family member
- Training on operations, animals and conservation
- Award and Recognition program
- Opportunities to make new friends and meet people with shared interests
- The satisfaction of working with talented, dedicated individuals devoted to bringing the important message of conservation of our aquatic resources to our guests.

What is the process for becoming a volunteer?

- Complete an online application.
- Staff will contact you to schedule an interview.
- Pay a non-refundable Administrative Fee of \$60 (includes: your yearly admission, discounted Annual Passes and tickets, a uniform shirt, name badge, training, etc.)
- Pass a background check.
- Attend basic volunteer training.
- Complete any other training classes and pre-requisites required for your chosen position.

The Volunteer Coordinator will communicate with you via e-mail or telephone to keep you informed as you move through the application and training process.

What else should I be aware of before I apply to volunteer?

- Volunteers are required to follow the uniform guidelines and other policies and procedures of Marineland Dolphin Adventure and Georgia Aquarium.
- Each volunteer commits to regular weekly schedule totaling at least 100 volunteer hours per year. Otherwise, a fee will be required the following year to continue in the program.
- Volunteer positions are based on the interests of the volunteer, the skills required, scheduling and seniority. Seniority is determined by the date the volunteer began his/her service and the number of hours served.
- All volunteers are expected to:
 - interact with the guests proactively, offering their assistance rather than waiting for it to be requested.
 - assist guests with the highest level of customer service.
 - represent the facility positively from their physical appearance while on duty to the ways that they speak of the park, the programs and the staff and animals.
